KEY ISSUES	 Aircraft operating low-level west of King Island, conducting random manoeuvring in Class G airspace Aircraft may be intermittently have Mode 3 off whilst flying TDA is designed clear of all air routes and well clear of land (SFC – FL120). No aircraft will be based at King Island so nil impact to local operators. King Island Airport operators were invited to provide feedback by email distribution on September 24 2019. No feedback was received. Request feedback by 30 November 2019.

MILITARY EXERCISE OCEAN EXPLORER 17 February – 08 March 2020

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Australian Defence Force will be conducting Exercise Ocean Explorer in South Eastern Australia between the Eastern Australia Exercise Area (EAXA) and King Island during the period 17 February – 08 March 2020.

1.2 The exercise will include maritime patrol and low-level jet aircraft in addition to ship-borne helicopter operations.

2. AIRSPACE

2.2 The following permanent restricted and danger areas will be activated by NOTAM during the period 17 - 25 February 2020 (see Appendix 1):

2.3 The following temporary danger area has been established to support low-level fast jet manoeuvres and will be activated by NOTAM during the period 24 February – 08 March 2020 (see Appendix 2):

YMMM/TDA King Island Military Flying Lateral Limits: 3900S 13940E, 3900S 14340E, 4030S 14340E, 4030S 13940E Vertical Limits: SFC – FL120 Hours of Activity: NOTAM Controlling Authority: Joint Airspace Control Cell (02) 6128 4857

3. MILITARY AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS

3.1 Within danger areas, high-speed military jet aircraft will be operating on random tracks without communications. Traffic information will not be provided to or about Exercise Ocean Explorer aircraft operating in danger areas.

3.2 Some aircraft within TDA King Island will be intermittently nil Mode 3 transponder during operations. This will be broadcast on appropriate CTAF or Broadcast Area frequencies.

2.4 Fly Neighbourly Advice. (FN22 NAVY WARSHIPS)

- 2.4.1 Pilots of civil aircraft and helicopters are to avoid warships by 5NM and are not to overfly below 2,000 FT AMSL. Pilots are not to circle the warship at any time.
- 2.4.2 Traffic alerts and warnings may be passed to aircraft operating in close proximity to warships on FREQ 121.5MHz.

2.5 Military aircraft will monitor, and when necessary broadcast on, the appropriate Area, CTAF or Broadcast Area frequency relative to their location.


